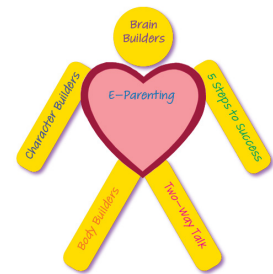

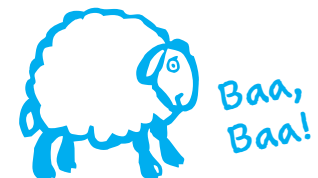

How to do this activity:

1. Use **Ready for Play and Learning** to see if your baby is ready to play and learn. Remember to use **5 Steps to Success** as you help your infant explore their natural curiosity during the activity.
2. Position your baby so that they can easily see you. Then select different animals to imitate. Make the animal sounds by using your voice, facial expressions, and body movements. Exaggerate all of these in a playful way.
3. Encourage your baby to copy the sounds by saying something like: **What does a dog say? A dog says woof, woof. Can you say woof?**
4. Remember to look for signs that tell you your infant may need a break from playing.
