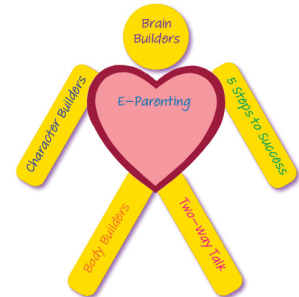

How to do this activity:

1. Use **Ready for Play and Learning** to see if your baby is ready to play and learn. Remember to use **5 Steps to Success** as you help your infant explore their natural curiosity during the activity.
2. Place a sticker or a small picture of a colorful object such as a bee, truck, butterfly, bird, or airplane on your finger tip. Making face-to-face contact with your baby, hold your finger about 10 inches from their face.
3. Move your finger around as if the object is flying through the air, keeping it at a distance where they can easily see it. Using a high pitched voice, say something like: **Do you see the bee? It's going buzz, buzz, buzz. Fly away, fly away, bee! Come back bee. Here it is. Buzz, buzz, buzz.** As your baby watches the sticker or picture, pretend it's flying behind you and then reappearing.
