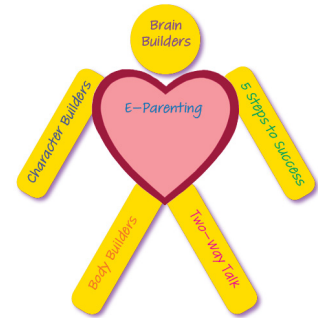

How to do this activity:

1. Use **Ready for Play and Learning** to see if your baby is ready to play and learn. Remember to use **5 Steps to Success** as you help your infant explore their natural curiosity during the activity.
2. If you'd like, put brightly colored lipstick on your lips. Then hold your baby close, so that they can see your face. Look directly at them and make sounds from your home language(s).
3. After making each sound, pause and wait for your infant to respond. If they respond with their own sounds, try to copy the sounds that your baby makes.
4. To make this activity more fun, you can say fun sentences to your infant as you continue to talk slowly and exaggerate the movement of your lips. For example, you might say something like: **I LOVE my itty-bitty baby.**
