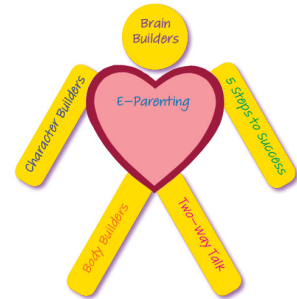

How to do this activity:

1. Use **Ready for Play and Learning** to see if your baby is ready to play and learn. Remember to use **5 Steps to Success** as you help your infant explore their natural curiosity during the activity.
2. Use a small blanket, towel, or large scarf to play peek-a-boo with your baby.
3. Place your infant in front of you. As they look at you, drape the fabric over your face and say something like: **Where am I?** or **Where did I go?**
4. Quickly pull the fabric away from your face, and when your baby sees you, make your voice very expressive and say: **Peek-a-boo...I love you!**
5. Repeat this several times until you notice your infant giving you cues and signals that let you know they're done with the activity.
