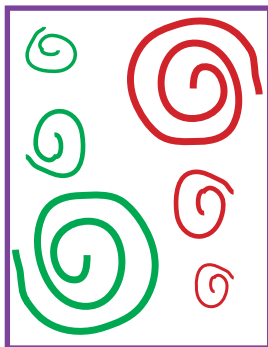
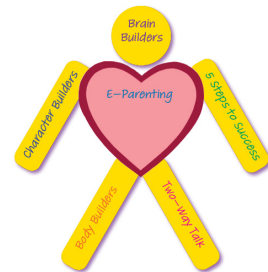

How to do this activity:

1. Use **Ready for Play and Learning** to see if your baby is ready to play and learn. Remember to use **5 Steps to Success** as you help your infant explore their natural curiosity during the activity.
2. Gather the **Picture Cards** you made. Remember, many parents like to store these cards near a place where they usually provide basic care to their baby.
3. Show your infant each card one-at-a-time. As your baby looks at the card, describe to them what they're seeing. For example, you might say something like: **Those are red swirls. These are green swirls. They are the same color as grass.**
4. After describing each card to your baby, remember to give them an opportunity to respond with their body movements, facial expressions, and sounds.
