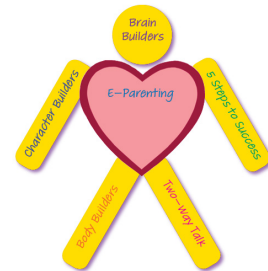

How to do this activity:

1. Use **Ready for Play and Learning** to see if your baby is ready to play and learn. Remember to use **5 Steps to Success** as you help your infant explore their natural curiosity during the activity.
2. Gather your **Abracadabra Scarves** and show your baby how to pull the scarves out of the box. You might want to say a fun magic word or rhyme such as:
Mecka, mecka, high...mecka hiney ho...
Mecka, mecka, high...mecka hiney low!
3. Once your infant has mastered pulling the scarves out of the box, show them how to push the scarves back in the box.
4. As your baby uses their problem-solving skills to learn about the scarves, talk with them about what they're hearing, seeing, doing, touching, and feeling.
