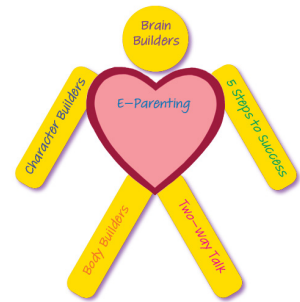

How to do this activity:

1. Use **Ready for Play and Learning** to see if your baby is ready to play and learn. Remember to use **5 Steps to Success** as you help your infant explore their natural curiosity during the activity.
2. Walk around your home with your baby and gather some safe household items they can play with to learn about how objects fit inside each other as well as different sizes.
3. Place the items on the floor and support them with exploring how to drop smaller objects in larger containers. As they explore the larger and smaller items, talk with them and support their feelings by saying things like: **You put the ball INSIDE the laundry basket. The ball is SMALLER. Uh oh, you're feeling upset. The BIG bowl won't fit inside the SMALL cup. Let's put the bowl INSIDE the basket. It will fit in there.**
