

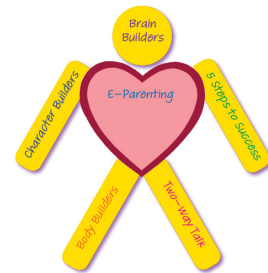

How to do this activity:

3. Show your baby the instruments and follow their lead to see which instrument they're interested in exploring first. Then support them with making music!
4. Invite other family members to join your band as you encourage your infant to sing, dance, and create music.
