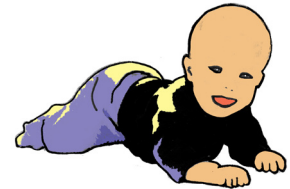

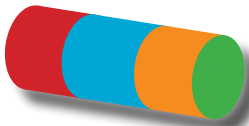
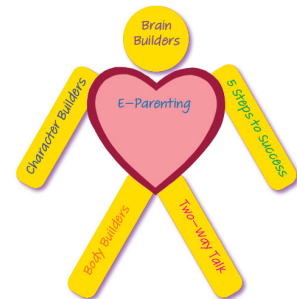

How to do this activity:

1. Use **Ready for Play and Learning** to see if your baby is ready to play and learn. Remember to use **5 Steps to Success** as you help your infant explore their natural curiosity during the activity.
2. Gather the rolling toy you made for your baby. Then put your infant on the floor and place them on their tummy. If your able, join your baby on the floor.
3. Show your infant how to roll the tube and reach for it or chase after it. You might even take turns rolling the tube back and forth in a simple game of toss.
4. As your baby plays with the tube, remember to support them with the feelings they're expressing. You might say something like:

You're feeling curious about the tube. Look at it roll! Now you're crawling after it. Catching that rolling tube sure did make you feel proud.
