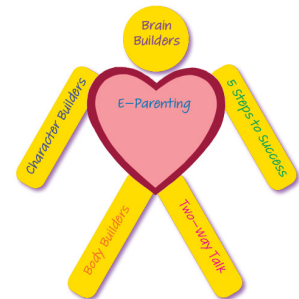

How to do this activity:

1. Use **Ready for Play and Learning** to see if your baby is ready to play and learn. Remember to use **5 Steps to Success** as you help your infant explore their natural curiosity during the activity.
2. If you're able, sit on the floor facing your infant with your legs extended and your knees apart. Then hold your baby's arms/shoulders as they're sitting and gently rock them back and forth as you sing **Row, Row, Row Your Boat** or another familiar song.
3. As you say the word **DREAM**, or the last word of another song, hold (baby's name)'s hands up high and act excited.
4. When you notice your infant getting tired of this game, practice the 3 steps of **E-Parenting** or talk with them about their feelings.
