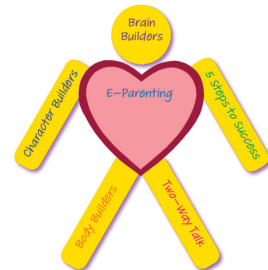

How to do this activity:

1. Use **Ready for Play and Learning** to see if your baby is ready to play and learn. Remember to use **5 Steps to Success** as you help your infant explore their natural curiosity during the activity.
2. Sit close to your baby or hold them in your lap as you face them. Choose a sound that your baby commonly makes from your home language(s), such as: **da, da, da** or **ma, ma, ma**.
3. With lots of expression on your face, sing this sound as a musical scale, high and low, and back again. Then wait a few seconds to see if your infant copies you or responds with other sounds, words, facial expressions, or body movements.
4. Remember, this a great activity to do during basic care routines!
